Reducing your

about how the information

your performance on		
the exam.		
Why: Spend at		
least ten minutes		
every week		
reviewing all of your previous		
notes. Reflect on		
the material and		
ask yourself questions based		
on what you've		
recorded in the		
Cue area. Cover the note-taking		
area with a piece		
of paper. Can you		
answer them?		

### STEP 3: SUMMARISE & REVIEW

What: Summarise the main ideas from the lesson.

What: At the end of the class lecture, discussion, or reading session.

How: In complete sentences, write down the conclusions that can be made from the information in your notes.

Why: Summarising the information after it's learned improves long-term retention.
